Obstacles will include jumps and tunnels only. This seminar has been wildly popular and is one you don't want to miss!

January 11 – Jumpers Coursework and Drills. Jumpers courses typically seen in UKI and USDAA Biathlon courses. All levels welcome.

January 12 - Handling Lines and Not Obstacles. All levels welcome. Having trouble with knocked bars, refusals or off courses? Need to learn more about your dog's leading leg and how to help him change his lead? This is the seminar for you. All levels welcome.

January 13 – Agility Coursework. Agility courses typically seen in UKI and USDAA Biathlon courses. We will work the course in pieces and then put it all together. All levels welcome. Dogs should be doing all equipment.
